

For this book report, you will create a book brochure that tells about the book you have just read. Take pride in your work. Use your best penmanship, add color and pictures, edit for spelling and grammar errors, and pay particular attention to your word choice. Neatness counts!

Materials Needed:

- Light colored $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ sheet of construction paper
- Crayons/colored pencils/markers/pens (NO PENCIL AND NO LINED PAPER)

Panels 1, 2, and 3 are on the **outside** of the brochure; panels 4, 5, and 6 are on the **inside** of the brochure.

Guidelines:

- Each response must be at least 8 sentences long.
- Fold the construction paper into three equal parts.


Outside:

- **Panel I**: If you could rewrite the ending, how would you have changed the story OR choose one part in the book that is special to you and tell why.
- Panel 2: Recommendation and student name. Would you recommend this book to others?
 Why or why not? Give evidence. Rate your book.
- Panel 3: Illustrate the main character as model vacationer. Include author, illustrator, publisher, your name, subject, and grade.

Inside:

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- Panel 4: Activities/Events/Occurrences. List events that took place in the book.
- Panel 5: Setting. Illustrate. What is the setting of the book? Describe with details.
- Panel 6: Supporting characters. Describe them and use them as models of visitors.



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
